In 2014, cyber attacks increased by 48% with an average of 117,339 per day

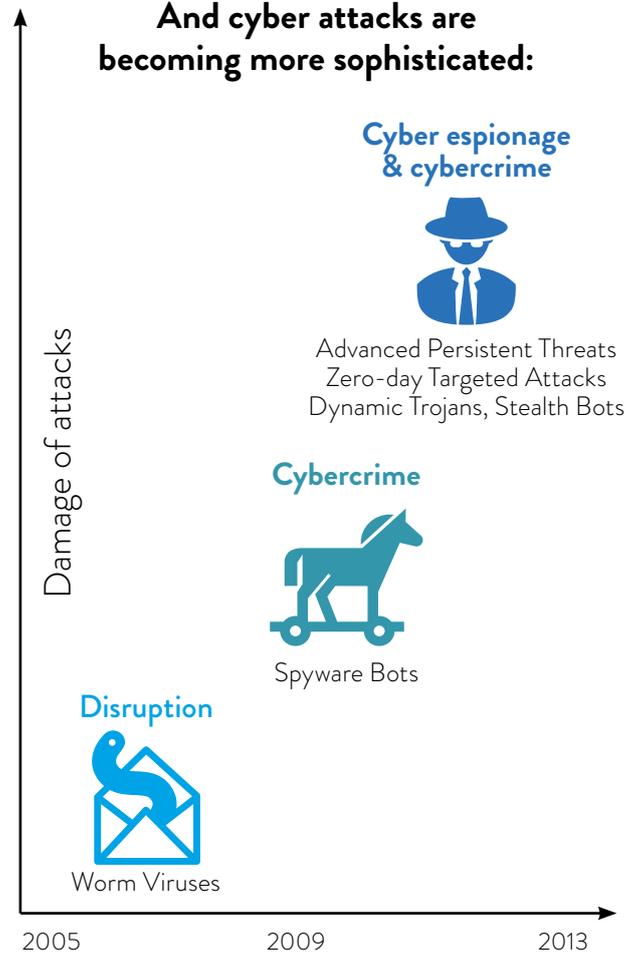


Security incidents cost businesses an average of **\$2.7 Million per year**



Total costs of cyber crime to the global economy is about **\$400 billion**

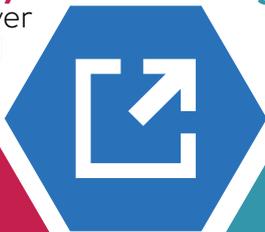
