We will also showcase disruptive start-ups in Al, Robotics, AR/VR, HealthTech and more so if you are looking to INSPIRE - DISRUPT - CONNECT, The BRIDGE is the place to be.

Speaker Profiles



Meet some of our exciting speakers for this year:

Dov Moran is Managing Partner of Grove Venture Capital and one of Israel's most prominent hi-tech leaders, entrepreneurs and investors. **He is best known for inventing the USB memory stick**. Dov was a Founder and CEO of M-Systems, a world leader in the flash data storage market. Under Dov's leadership, M-Systems grew to \$1B revenue and was acquired by SanDisk Corp for \$1.6B., one of the biggest acquisitions in Israel.

Professor Amnon Shashua is the co-founder of Mobileye and OrCam, and an expert in computer vision and machine learning. MobilEye driving assistance use systems-on-chip and computer vision algorithms for detecting pedestrians, vehicles, and traffic signs, and is moving forward on autonomous driving technology. Mobileye's IPO on the NYSE was the biggest Israeli IPO ever, raising \$1B at a market cap of \$5.3B. The company is partnering with the BMW Group and Intel to make a self-driving car a reality by 2021.

Eugene Kandel is the CEO of Start-Up Nation Central, a non-profit dedicated to strengthening Israel's innovation ecosystem. He has formerly served as the Head of the National Economic Council, where he identified innovation as a key driver for the growth of the Israeli economy. He has also served as Economic Adviser to the Prime Minister of Israel, and was instrumental in spearheading bilateral economic cooperation between Israel and China, the United States, Germany and Canada.

Cecile Blilious is the Founder and Managing Partner at Impact First Investments, Israel's first impact venture fund. Impact First is exclusively focused on investing in technology companies that are creating innovative ways to address global social challenges through new ideas, technologies and business models. Prior to founding Impact First, Cecile managed the Noaber Foundation's Israeli investments for over 14 years, and has extensive hands-on management experience with high-tech start-ups.

Nagraj Kashyap is Corporate VP and Global Head at Microsoft Ventures, which has a presence in Tel Aviv. Nagraj has over 20 years of experience in mobile and software with an emphasis on venture capital. At The BRIDGE, he will be presenting his insights on the Israeli innovation ecosystem and why the country is the 'go-to' place for corporate venturing efforts.

Hillel Milo is one of the pioneers of the venture capital industry in Israel. He has extensive investment experience with Israeli hi-tech companies and is personally responsible for over twenty exits. In 2008 he cofounded Aquagro Fund, a \$50 million cleantech fund with investments in nine companies in the areas of water, smart agriculture and renewable energy. The Fund has made three exits to date.

Hot Israeli Start-ups to Meet at The BRIDGE



ElMindA aims to create a paradigm shift in managing brain disorders and injuries. It has developed a high-resolution visual imaging technology platform that monitors and evaluates the state of the brain, and changes in brain activity.

EQUInom is one of Israel's most exciting agritech companies, with expertise in breeding sesame and quinoa. The company raised \$1.25 million in early 2016 and are undertaking a project to introduce sesame crops in Australia. EQUInom's advanced seed breeding technology allows it to grow sturdier and healthier crop varieties that can be machine harvested.

AirRobotics develops drones that operate autonomously, and which are particularly suited for carrying out industrial tasks in complex industries such as mining, oil and gas, and seaports. The company launched publicly in June 2016 and has already raised raised \$28.5 million, with support from a wide range of investors including the Israeli Chief Scientist's Office, UpWest Labs.

Travelers Box offers travellers an innovative way to get rid of their unused foreign currency. Users are able to deposit their currency into an online account to redeem gift cards from leading brands like Starbucks, GooglePlay, Skype, iTunes and others.
